Principles of Working with Policy Makers

- 1. Decide what you want as your outcome.
- 2. Articulate a crisp message with a specific request/questions.
- 3. Research the policy makers capabilities.
- 4. Know the timeline and process of policy development.
- 5. Find a vehicle; a tragic event, a report, etc.
- 6. Bring good background materials so you can get to the issues.
- 7. Determine a strategy/risk assessment: should you attack the issue in whole or on phases.
- 8. Identify and perhaps name the opposition, obstacles, etc.
- 9. Decide your broad strategy and let the policy maker know.
- 10. Connect to the policy makers interests.
- 11. Use policy makers concepts and language.
- 12. Share or give credit with the policy maker.
- 13. Strategize about when you should employ the media.
