- ① Look to a British-Irish Agreement, as a replacement for AIA.
- ② Removal of Articles 2+3 (28.8.85) (repudiation of the right of self-determination) — in order to see political progress.
— in order to help deal with terrorism
- ③ An understanding of the Union (- the Queen + Parliament)
- ④ The constitutional status. — defined. Emphasizes the right to self-determination — implies the "Community-ness of it."
- ⑤ Accepts that what he said is not an argument for "unfettered majority-rule." (Spinners talk — parochialism?)
- ⑥ Conduct at Westminster. — stop Orders in Council and select committee structure.
- ⑦ Would have wanted a select committee during the life-time of Stormont.
- ⑧ Resents the "imposition" of European influence.
- ⑨ Bill of Rights for the whole nation.
- ⑩ Failure of 1973 + 1982 — they must not fail.
- ⑪ fundamental democracy. — there must be a possibility for change of government.
- ⑫ There must be stability.
- ⑬ Only Rights can be guaranteed.
