Statement for clarification of our position on the final sub-item
in Agenda Item 6.

1 There are genuine Unionist fears and concerns about the Irish Constitution, in particular Articles 2 & 3.

2 Only removal of those Articles can ameliorate these fears and concerns.

3 We are asking the Government of the Irish Republic to sponsor changes in the Constitution, including the necessary referendum, to address these fears and concerns, subject to a satisfactory conclusion of the talks as a whole.
