Terrorism in all its manifestations is utterly repugnant and is an obstacle to the building of a new relationship between the people of Ireland. The desire of people throughout the island is for the achievement of political progress through the establishment of a new institutional framework, the ending of terrorism and the attainment of peace and stability.

- to continue to give priority to the fight against terrorism;
- to continue to build upon effective security cooperation;
- to maintain and develop effective legal cooperation in bringing the perpetrators of terrorism to justice; and
- to foster public confidence in the security forces and in the administration of justice.
