HEADS OF DELEGATION MEETING: 24 JULY 1992

CHAIRMAN'S AIDE-MEMOIRE

- . It was agreed that there would be a substantial session of Strand 2, probably of some days' duration, in Dublin in the week beginning 21 September
 - the Chairman would endeavour to ensure that there would be a substantive committee report ready by that time to warrant a plenary meeting.
- . Assurances were given by the leaders of the UK and Irish Government delegations that adequate transport and security arrangements would be made for all delegations.
- . With the acceptance of the formulation for the Strand 2 meeting in Dublin, the future programme of work as drawn up by the Business Committee was agreed.
- . The Chairman indicated that there would be no discussion in Plenary on the responses that delegations were planning to deliver and/or circulate.
- . The Chairman indicated that delegations would be given the opportunity to indicate in the final session of the current Plenary those matters within Item 6 of the Agenda which were of particular interest to them
 - this might provide some guidance to delegations in their preparation of papers during the recess.
