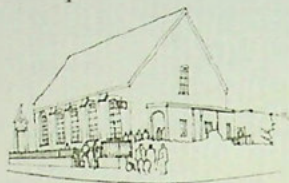
**Re: United Prayer Breakfast**

Dear John,

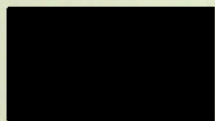
I am writing to you to inform you that for various reasons I will not be able to continue serving on the Steering Group of the U.P.B.
