

Warehouse and Ships Burned.
Port Costa, Cal., Aug. 26.—Fire has destroyed McNear's warehouse and burned the ship America to the water's edge.

There are three warehouses burned. The fire was confined to warehouse No. 2, where six hundred tons of wheat were stored.

A HOME LESSON.
Word comes that the ranchmen and fruit growers of Southern California are about to present a memorial to Congress setting forth that, on account of the destruction of forests on their mountain ridges the streams of the lower region are drying up and thus depriving the country of the means of irrigation.

The memorial asks that the timber claim system be abolished in that portion of the State before the last vestige of mountain foliage disappears forever.
