DRAFT SECURITY CONTRIBUTION TO SUMMIT COMMUNIQUÉ

You asked if I had any suggestions for a draft passage on security co-operation in the Summit Communiqué. Would the following be of any use?

"The Prime Minister and the Taoiseach condemned the latest terrorist attacks in Northern Ireland and reaffirmed their determination to maintain and further develop security co-operation in order to help bring a permanent end to terrorism. They welcomed recent arms and explosives finds in Britain, the Republic and Northern Ireland. The two leaders also reviewed some specific issues and identified a number of areas where further work should be undertaken to examine the potential for enhanced co-operation."
