LIAISON GROUP MEETING

At the Liaison Group meeting today we agreed to meet again in Dublin at 11am on Wednesday 2 March.

2. Mr Williams, I know, has another commitment; and Mr Daniell will be with Sir John Wheeler and PUS in the USA.

3. If, as I think, each of you is free I hope you will attend the meeting. (Obviously I leave it to Mr Blatherwick to decide whether he or John Dew should attend.)

4. Though the Irish side did not quite promise a paper, we are certainly left with the legitimate hope and expectation that they may produce something in time for the meeting. Certainly there is no expectation, still less a commitment, that the British side will table anything additional at this stage.
