Dear Trime Timitin,

You are meeting the Unionist Leaders this afternoon. You should be in no doubt that we are increasingly angry at those who are frustrating every attempt to make progress.

These talks are vastly more important than the venue. The people of Northern Ireland are anxious to see progress and are impatient with the obstructive stance of those who are delaying the talks. Goodwill and patience are being squandered. The Secretary of State is an honourable man who has demonstrated patience and understanding throughout, but these very qualities are leaving him and the process vulnerable to gross abuse.

The negotiations are now in the gravest jeopardy. Only a firm stance by you will protect the talks from collapse, the community from a major upsurge in violence, and Her Majesty's Government from the accusation of surreptiously playing the "Orange Card".
