Gives account of extracts from Hume/Adams....

1. British Government to repeat that there is no selfish, strategic or economic interest in NI.
2. British and Irish Governments to give a solemn commitment to foster agreement and reconciliation leading to a new political framework founded on consent and encompassing the whole island.
3. British Government to state that the Irish people have the right collectively to self-determination.
4. Irish Government to state that self-determination must be exercised with the consent of the people of Northern Ireland.
5. IRA violence will stop completely.
6. The five parties and two governments will then meet in conference to agree a settlement.
