Dear Co-ordinator/Delegation Secretary,

I am circulating herewith a proposed revised calendar of meetings. This supersedes that circulated with my letter of 15 September. The changes reflect

- (1) the unavailability of Dr Bradley in the remainder of October and of Professor Kevin Boyle on 27 October
- (2) the discussions and agreements at the Co-ordinating Committee on 28 September, at the Sifting Committee on 5 October and (on Forum calendar business) at the Drafting Committee on 6 October
- (3) the unavailability soon of some of the presenters identified by the Sifting Committee,
- (4) views received from delegations on such issues as prisoners, victims of violence and the timing of the proposed visit to Belfast; and
- (5) considerations of balance, in various senses of that word.

Revised versions of the calendars for sub-committees and of the grid of meetings are also attached.

The Secretariat hope to consult delegations very soon on the acceptability of this programme, whether in the wings of forthcoming meetings or otherwise.
