

Key Issues

The following is a summary of the key issues as submitted by some of the participants (not listed in any order of priority):



Strand One

- new arrangements in Northern Ireland - An Assembly, its purpose, composition, functions, responsibilities, relations with other institutions including GB, checks and balances, safeguards
- confidence issues - policing arrangements, demilitarisation, prisoners.

Strand Two

- new North/South arrangements - purpose, composition, powers, functions, responsibilities; relations with other institutions.

Strand Three

- new intergovernmental and other arrangements within these islands - purpose, composition, functions and responsibilities.

Constitutional Issues

- the principle of consent
- sovereignty
- Articles 2 and 3 of the Irish Constitution
- British constitutional legislation

Rights and Safeguards

- protection of human, civil, and cultural rights; equality; justice.

Other

- validation of agreement.
 - consent
 - referendum
 - parliamentary passage
