that any other member has given
his vote or influence for or against
any other measure or proposition
of such Legislature, is guilty of
treason.

Any such person who is guilty
of either of such offences shall be
expelled and shall not thereafter
be eligible to the Legislature or
the rights of suffrage, and on conviction
of such offence in the Senate,
shall be liable to such further
penalty as may be prescribed
by law.
