**GARDA FINDS SINCE LAST SUMMIT (16 JUNE 1993) - SUMMARY**

<u>Location</u>	<u>Date</u>	<u>Details</u>
Smithboro, Co Monaghan	19 June	A considerable quantity of weapons, ammunition, bomb-making components, and assorted terrorist equipment-radios, manuals etc - were recovered in a planned operation.
Blarney, Co Cork	6 July	Garda recovered weapons and ammunition during a search of a PIRA suspect's house.
Ballybofey, Co Donegal	4 August	Garda recovered 1500 lbs of primed HME from a shed. Four arrests were made and one man charged.
	6-7 August	In a follow-up operation, 3 rifles, 2 sub-machine guns and an RPG 7 rocket launcher were recovered. A suspected PIRA firing range was found.
Busaras, Dublin and Dundalk, Co Louth	24 August	Unexploded UVF incendiaries were found at the Central Bus Station in Dublin and at a depot in Dundalk.
Currahill, Omeath Co Lough	29 September	A planned Garda search uncovered a number of rifles, shotguns, and ammunition, and PIRA firing range believed to be part of a PIRA training camp.
Omeath, Co Louth	2 October	In the follow-up operation, 5 weapons and ammunition were recovered.
Ravensdale, Co Louth	3-5 October	Explosive material, 3 spigot bombs and bomb-making equipment were recovered in an underground bunker in a forest during a planned search.

Special Criminal Court Dublin	7 October	Pearse McAuley, PIRA member, who escaped from HMP Brixton in 1991 with Nessan Quinlivan; captured in the Republic and sentenced to 7 years imprisonment for possession of a firearm and ammunition.
	18 November	Quinlivan sentenced to 4 years imprisonment for possession of a firearm.
Donegal town	19 November	A routine search by the Garda uncovered more than a quarter of a ton of HME (650 lbs) packed into 10 plastic bags in a derelict farmhouse at Ardchicken, just to the south of Donegal town, Co. Donegal. The material was in good condition. No other accessories were found.
Store Street,	23 November	Garda discovered and made Dublin safe a 6 inch pipe bomb planted by loyalists in a Telecom Eireann inspection chamber beside Store Street Garda Station in Dublin.
